Nestled on the ground floor of the Historic Edgewater Hotel, sits a charming dining room bringing some of the best Thai Food in Central Florida to Winter Garden. Winner of the Orlando Magazine’s Dining Award and the Orlando Sentinel Foodie Award for Critic’s Choice as Best Thai Restaurant for the past four years running, Thai Blossom serves up authentic, traditional and delicious Thai Food to its guests seven days a week.

Owners Tyler and Patcharee Cravens are proud of their food and the culture it represents, and serve it with grace and style in a warm atmosphere rich with hints of Thai décor. Patcharee is originally from Saraburi, one of the central provinces of Thailand, and Tyler from Jackson, Mississippi. Patcharee’s well-honed recipes and Tyler’s restaurant prowess has proved to be a powerful combination as their success has shown since their opening in mid-2008.

The entire courteous staff wears traditional Thai attire and the kitchen creates classics such as Pad Thai & Pad Se-ew, Panang, and a variety of curries. Among the appetizers are steamed dumplings, summer rolls, and a delicious array of Tom Yum, Tom Kah, and many other savory soups. Overall, the extensive menu showcases nearly 100 items, all available with spices ranging from mild to Thai hot. The restaurant also serves Asian and domestic beers, red and white wines, plum wine and saké.
